## Village of Oak Park Fire Department

- ▶ Three Stations
  - ▶ Station One (100 N. Euclid)
    - ▶ Command Vehicle
    - ▶ One Advanced Life Support (ALS) Tower Ladder
    - ▶ 2 ALS Ambulances
    - ▶ Reserve Vehicles
  - ▶ Station Two (212 Augusta)
    - ▶ One ALS equipped Fire Engine
  - ▶ Station Three (900 S. East)
    - ▶ One ALS equipped Fire Engine
    - ▶ One ALS Ambulance\*\*

# Current Model For Service

## Village of Oak Park Fire Department

- ▶ Sworn members are Cross Trained as both Firefighters and Paramedic.
  - ▶ Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) Certified and Licensed as Emergency Medical Technicians -Paramedic (EMT-P).
    - ▶ Highest Licensed Prehospital Advanced Life Support (ALS) providers that traditionally respond to 911 request for service at the municipal level.
    - ▶ Administrative Code driven with minimum 1,000 hours curriculum (500 hours didactic 500 hour clinical). With recertification requiring approved Continuing Education (C.E.) hours per cycle.
    - ▶ Required graduation from certified program and currently held IDPH Paramedic License.
  - ▶ Illinois Basic Operations Firefighter Certification through Illinois Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM).
    - ▶ 320 hours basic Firefighting education/practical skills
    - ▶ Company Officers have additional scene and organizational training and C.E.

# Current Model For Service

## Village of Oak Park Fire Department

- ▶ I.D.P.H Paramedic/ EMD ability/authority to practice prehospital medicine.
  - ▶ (210 ILCS 50/) Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Systems Act.
  - ▶ "Advanced Life Support (ALS) Services" means an advanced level of pre-hospital, cardiac monitoring, cardiac defibrillation, electrocardiography, intravenous therapy, administration of medications, drugs and solutions, use of adjunctive medical devices, trauma care.
  - ▶ That care shall be initiated as authorized by the EMS Medical Director in a Department approved advanced life support EMS System, under the written or verbal direction of a physician licensed to practice medicine in all of its branches or under the verbal direction of an Emergency Communications Registered Nurse.
  - ▶ Broken down into geographic regions across the state, designated further to Resource Hospital, Medical Director, Standing Medical Orders (S.M.O.) (medication and policies/procedures), designation of transport for medical care (i.e. trauma center)
  - ▶ Emergency Medical Dispatchers (E.M.D.) are also mandated with strict questions and benchmarks to have emergency responders moving to emergency.

## Village of Oak Park Fire Department

- ▶ Illinois Basic Operations Firefighter Certification through Illinois Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM).
  - ▶ Personal Protective Equipment, Firefighter Safety, Ground Ladders Skills, Tools & Equipment, Forcible Entry - in/out doors, Fire Department Communications, Vehicle Extrication - Safety/Awareness- Technology Vehicle Extrication - Techniques
  - ▶ Behavioral/Stress Management, Substance Use Disorder (SUD), Firefighter Decontamination



# Current Model For Service

## Village of Oak Park Fire Department

- ▶ Value added of tested certified and equipped Fire Rescue staff.
  - ▶ “First do no harm”
    - ▶ Proper tools, equipment continues training
    - ▶ Welfare Check above ground level
    - ▶ Forced Entry (minus barricade situation)
    - ▶ Vehicle Extrication
    - ▶ Return to Service/reduce post event repairs

# Current Model For Service

## Village of Oak Park Fire Department

- ▶ Village of Oak Park Paramedics operate as “Borrowed Servants”
  - ▶ Operate under Standing Medical Orders of our Medical Director (eff 10/01/21).
  - ▶ Medical Control for unorthodox or deviation from "normal" situations
    - ▶ Use of Involuntary Committals
  - ▶ Known or suspected drug or alcohol use, unaccompanied minors or unreliable patients.
- ▶ Mandatory Reporters
  - ▶ Suspected Abuse/ Neglect
  - ▶ Suspected Child/Elder Abuse or Financial Exploitation
  - ▶ Suspected Domestic/Sexual
  - ▶ Suspected Abuse/Neglect of the Mentally Ill/ Developmentally Disabled

## Village of Oak Park Fire Department

- ▶ All Hazard Fire and Rescue Department
  - ▶ 8,112 Calls for service Dec 13, 2022 (approx. 25 a day)
    - ▶ EMS, Fire, Service Calls, Assist, Investigations (smoke, hazard)
    - ▶ Non response Calls, CPR class, Car Seat Reviews, School Education, Smoke Detector Programs,
    - ▶ Fire Prevention Bureau, building inspection, plan reviews, service questions, alarm verification
  - ▶ Mutual Aid Box Alarms System Division 11 (M.A.B.A.S)
    - ▶ Hazard Materials Response
    - ▶ Technical Rescue

# Current Model For Service

## Village of Oak Park Fire Department

- ▶ We respond to request for service and preplanned community events.
  - ▶ 911 is activated Phone, Radio, Text, Social Media
  - ▶ Calls are triaged and we are dispatched, type and location.
  - ▶ What kind of request
    - ▶ Fire/EMS/Assist other agency, emergency/non emergency
  - ▶ Placed into one of 26 EMS related "buckets"
  - ▶ Update in route can upgrade or downgrade Calls
    - ▶ Breathing Status, Weapons, Number of people involved, etc.
  - ▶ Transport or Refusal (release to third party P.W., Utility)

# Current Model For Service

## Village of Oak Park Fire Department

- ▶ Interdepartmental cooperation
  - ▶ Public Works, Legal Review, Human Resource, Village Managers Office
- ▶ Police
  - ▶ Extensive working relationship
  - ▶ 1 April 2022 Meeting between Deputy Chiefs (Police - Deputy Chief Johnson, Moran, Fire- Deputy Chief Terry, Fadden)
    - ▶ Internal FD clarification Company officer will meet Police Supervisor prior to patient contact
    - ▶ Updated “terminology” prior to dispatch (assure correct staffing assigned\*\*)
    - ▶ “Face to Face” once on scene
    - ▶ Ongoing assessment of bottleneck

- ▶ Disclaimers
  - ▶ Data is from transport information, generalities not on scene
  - ▶ New Software cutover 25 April 2022, projections, estimates
  - ▶ Address prior questions (demographic, housing stability) in examples
  - ▶ Not addressing legal aspect of calls, rather planning moving forward
  - ▶ Expectation of Privacy for data displayed



# Current Model For Service

## Village of Oak Park Fire Department

- ▶ Nature of Call (dispatch “Bucket”) information given
- ▶ Primary Impression (acute diagnose, treatment rendered, SMO’s used)
- ▶ Looked at transport data from April 25- 12 Dec 2022\* V Berry Dunn table 3.4
  - ▶ 615 transports (Psychiatric, Unconscious/ Fainting, Opiate Use, Poisoning)
  - ▶ Number of calls/months roughly 72.35 calls per month.

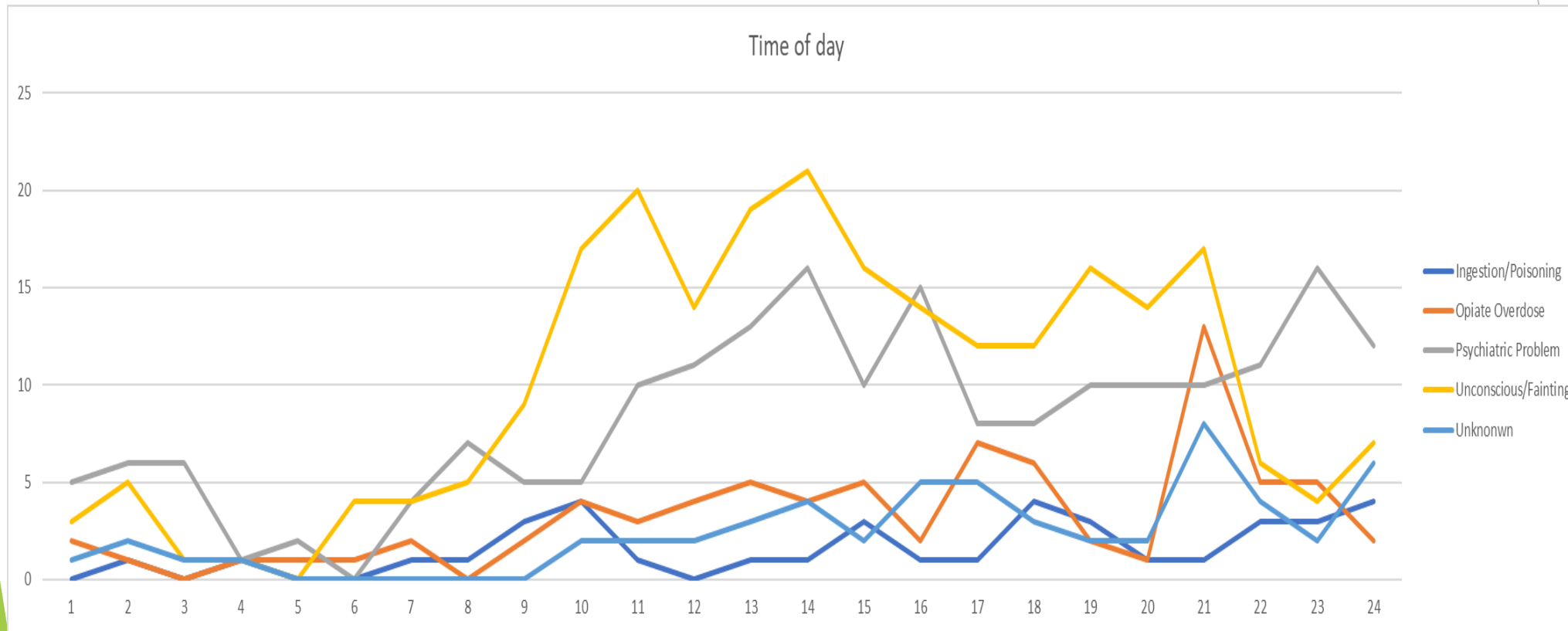

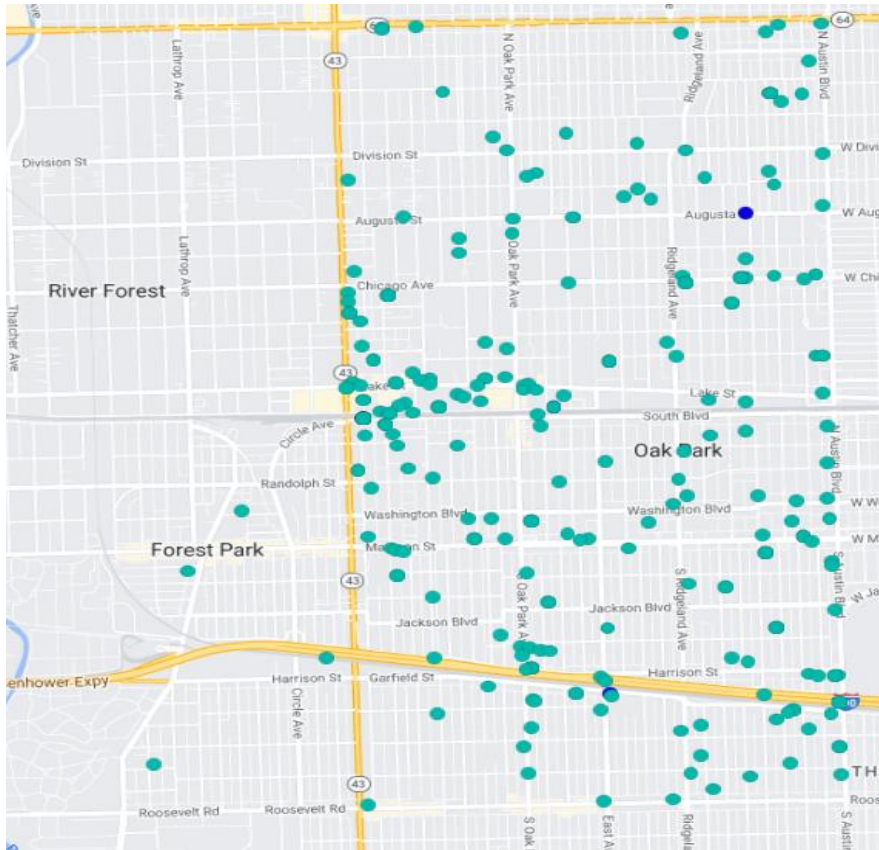

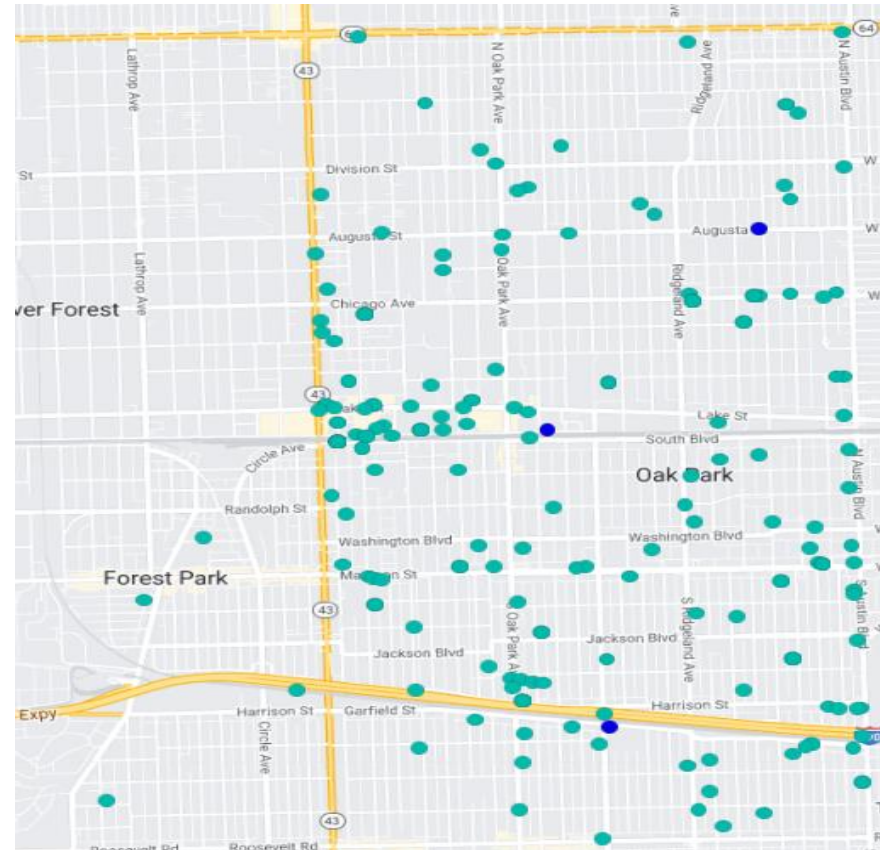

Primary Impression (Psychiatric Disorder)

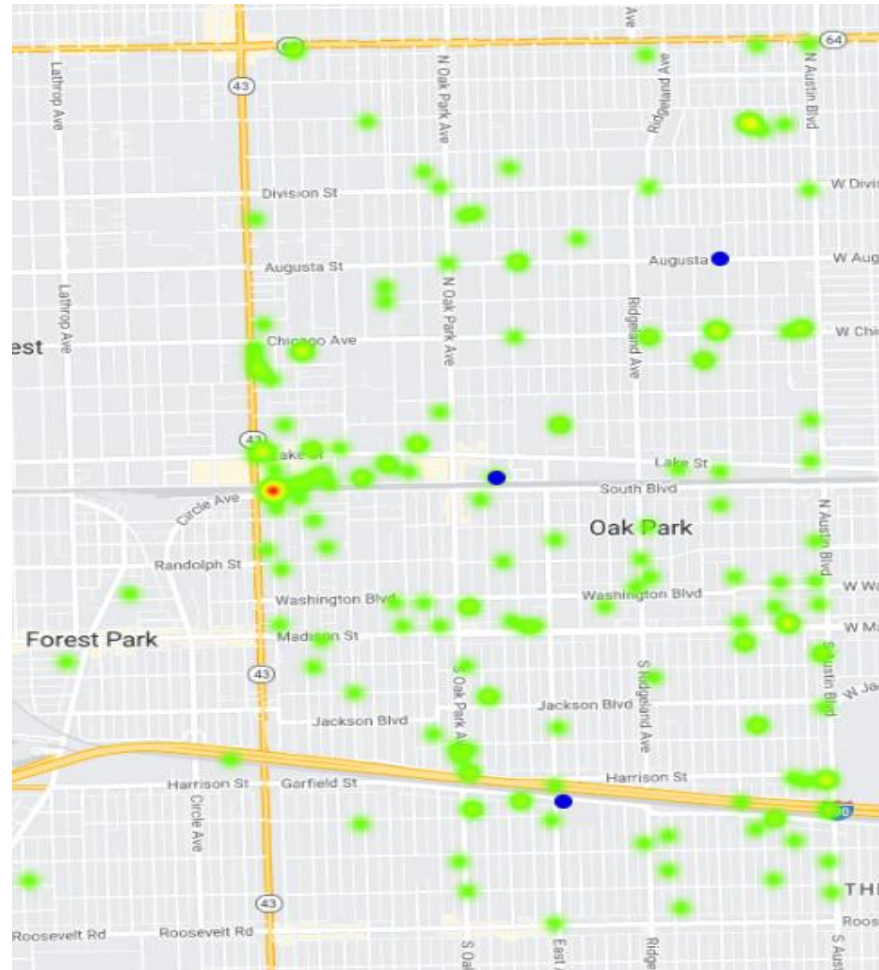


Nature of call (Psychiatric Problem)



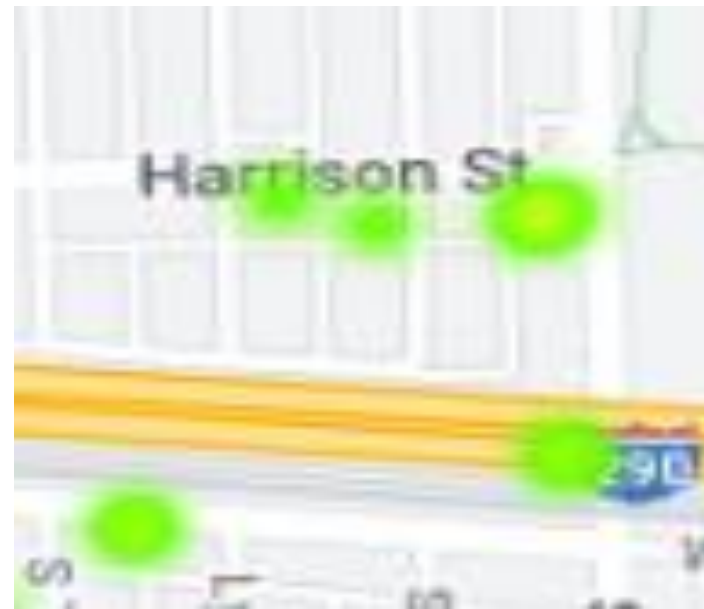
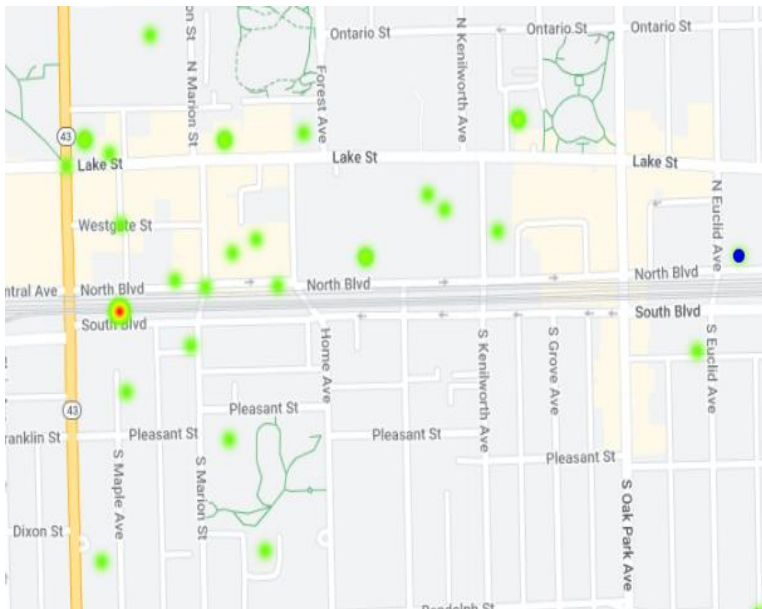

[REDACTED] related [REDACTED] stated he was going to commit suicide by cop before R/O's arrival. While on scene [REDACTED] stated he was going to walk into Lake Michigan and kill himself.

Sgt. Ruiz requested OPFD to respond to the scene due to [REDACTED]'s statements regarding hurting himself. OPFD #612 arrived on scene and determined [REDACTED] had to be transported to Rush Oak Park Hospital to seek psychiatric evaluation. R/O requested several times for [REDACTED] to get up and walk to the ambulance to which [REDACTED] refused. R/O proceeded to grab [REDACTED] by the wrist in attempt to escort [REDACTED] to the ambulance. [REDACTED] proceeded to pull his hands away and stiffened his arms and body. R/Os placed Radovich into hand cuffs and escorted [REDACTED] to the ambulance for transport. R/O traveled in the ambulance and [REDACTED] was transported to OPH without further incident.
