The Village of Oak Park ("Village") provides a Snow Removal Assistance Program ("Program") to property owners who meet low income limit requirements (see chart on page 2) and have a documented medically diagnosed disability that prevents such a person from removing sidewalk snow. The Village utilizes a third party to clear snow and ice from public sidewalks only. Snow will be cleared from the public sidewalk adjacent to the property within 24 hours after the end of accumulating snowfall.
