**COVID-19 Status Report
Oak Park Village Board of Trustees**

To: Village President and Village Board of Trustees

The memo is a means to share a brief summary of information regarding Village of Oak Park operational activities in response to COVID-19. In most cases, formal public guidance or employee guidance has been publicly disseminated via the Village website or Village social media channels.

New Public Health Guidance

Today, the Village of Oak Park Department of Public Health received notification of the following new COVID-19 cases:

Excluding individuals for which street addresses are not yet determined, the State of Illinois reports a total of two thousand six hundred and nine (2609) Oak Park COVID-19 cases. It is important to note that as patient tracking and case follow-up occurs, individuals listing the number of Oak Park cases reported may change depending on residency confirmation.

The Oak Park Department of Public Health is notified of positive tests as established by state and local public health protocol. Because of privacy laws, no additional information can be released about the individuals. It is noted, that privacy precludes location information regarding individuals tested to anyone other than Public Health Officials and First Responders.

The Oak Park Department of Public Health is working closely with officials from the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH), investigating and notifying anyone who may have had exposure to the individual who tested positive for COVID-19. Local public health officials, hospitals and first responders are following protocols consistent with the latest guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

Vaccinations

Through today, seven of the nine properties in Oak Park (which are classified either Phase 1a or 1b) have completed “first dose” vaccinations by either the Oak Park Public Health Department or via the State/Federal Long-Term Care Facility vaccination program. Second doses at some facilities that were classified as Phase 1a eligible are also beginning. There are approximately 630 residents living in Phase 1a eligible Long Term Care facilities which include Belmont Village, Berkley Nursing Home, Brookdale, Oak Park Arms, Oasis Oak Park. There are approximately 540 residents living at Independent Senior Housing facilities (which are also income eligible) and include Ryan Farrelly Apartments, Heritage House, The Oaks and Mills Tower.

Cases related to Long-Term Care and Assisted Living Facilities

Interim Public Health Director Terry reported one (1) new resident case at Oak Park Arms.

Public Health Data

Interim Public Health Director Terry has shared the following data related to COVID-19.

“New cases per 100,000 People”. This metric looks at the number of recent COVID-19 cases per 100,000 people to describe the potential number of people who are currently ill and may be infectious. This is the number of new cases reported by IDPH in the previous week. Calculated as a rate = [Village of Oak Park case count for 7 days] / [Village population] x100,000.

- Oak Park rate: 106/100,000
- Cook County rate: 253/100,000 1/17/2021 through 1/23/2021)
- Target for County-level data: Cases for the week are fewer than 10 or the rate is fewer than 50 cases per 100,000 people
- Warning for County-level data: New case rate is greater than 50 cases per 100,000 people

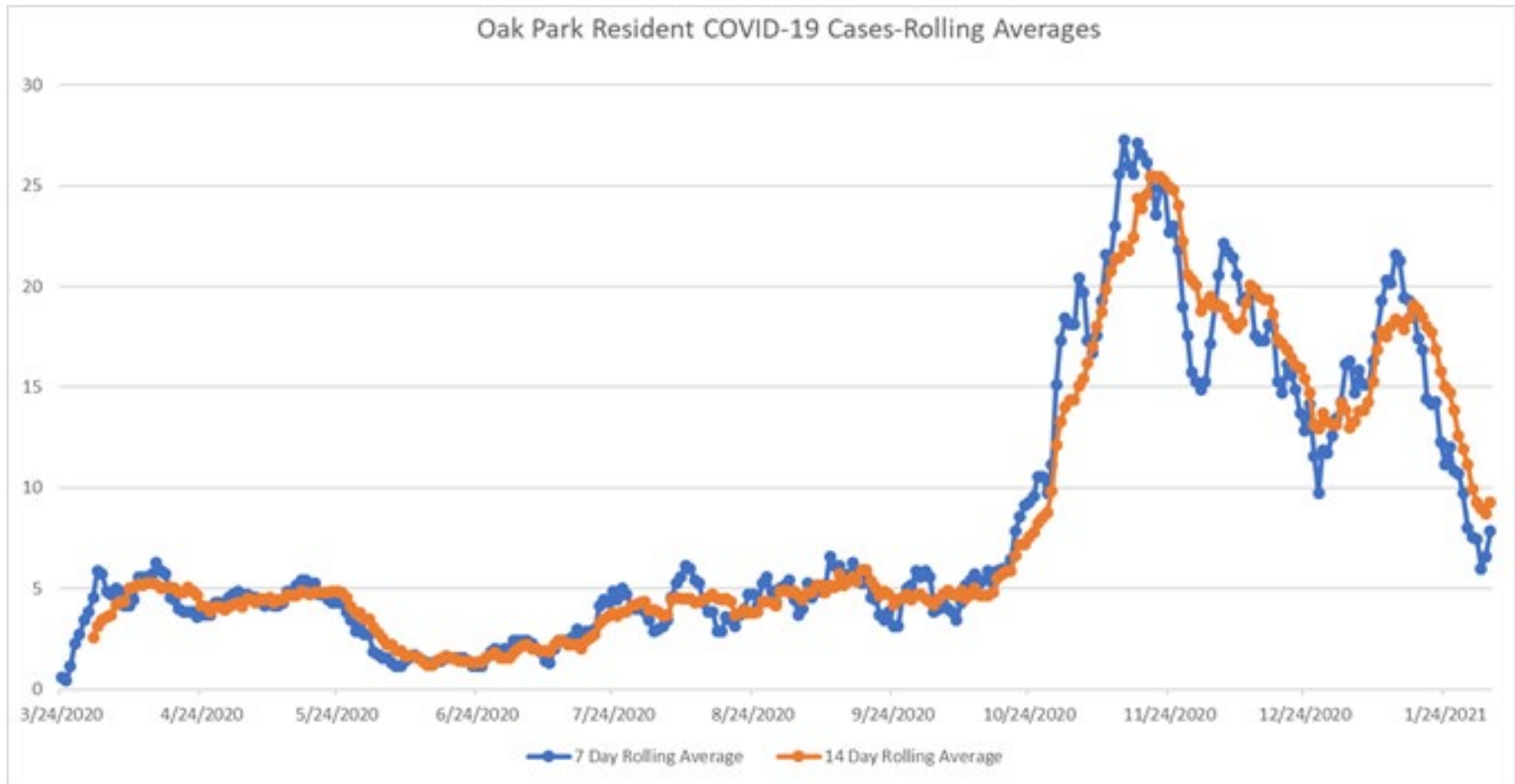

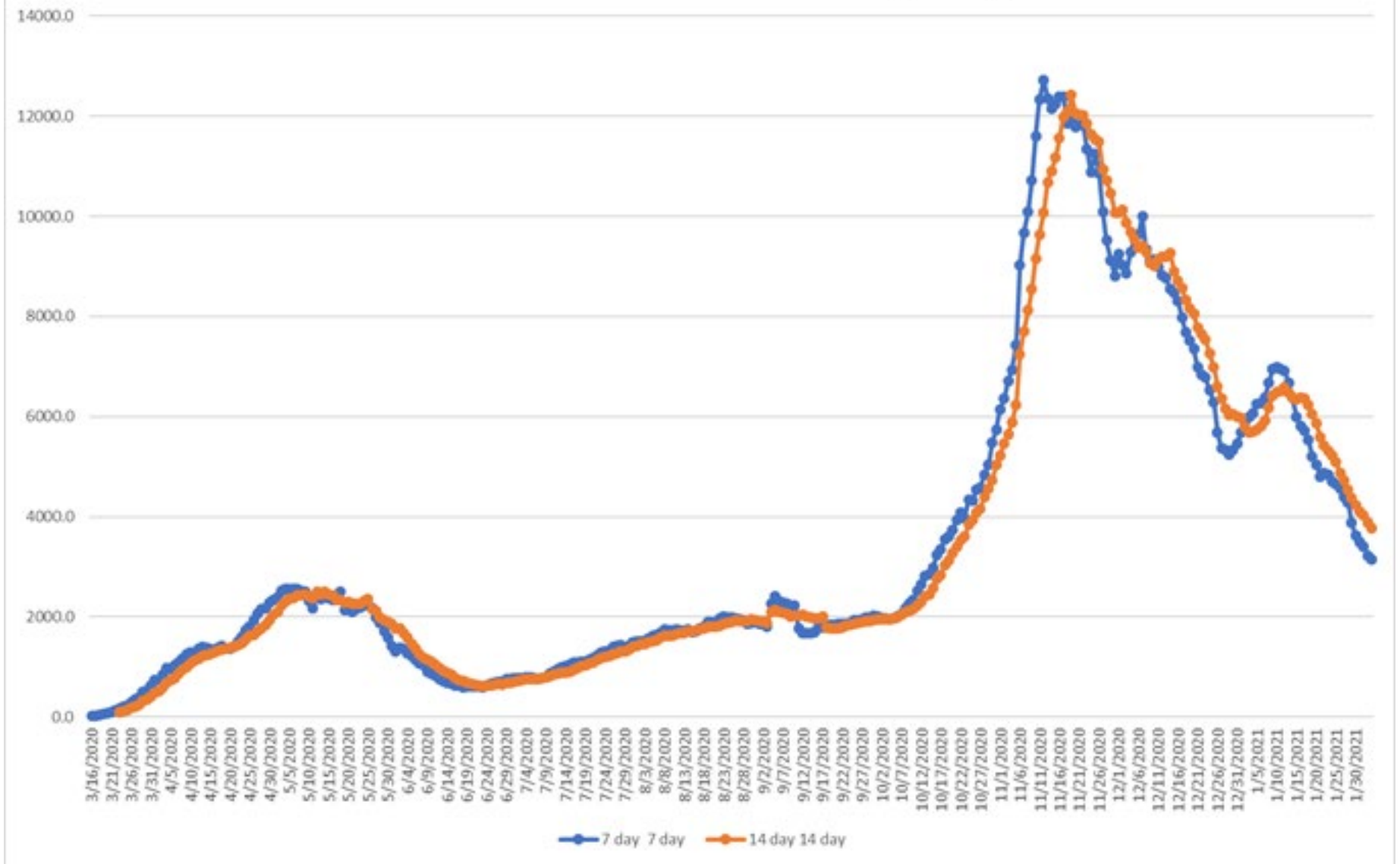
