- 80% of the 30 respondents to the permit counter survey "agreed" or "strongly agreed" that their overall service experience was excellent


## Year-to-Date Permit Application Volume and Revenue Through end of July for Each Year (including Online Permits)



The number of permits issued in July was about 10 percent higher than that in the previous month. The year-to-date total is about 17 percent higher than last year at this time.

## Monthly Plan Review Volume by Category and % Completed On-Time Across All Case Types


Turn around time is calculated from date of application to completion of initial review by all Village departments. Chart does not include processing of Online Permits




Total number of plan reviews performed increased by 4 percent in July over the previous month. As of the end of the month, there were 26 applications in the review queue with 7 cases overdue an average of 7 days, mainly Category 2 reviews. An additional case came out of a 2 month hold for historic review and was added to the building review list.


## Plan Review Volume and Initial Review Pass Rate by Permit Category July 2013
