


The following graphs represent department workload and performance related to construction activities within the Village for the month of March 2014. In addition, noteworthy department activities and accomplishments in the month of March included:

- Permits were issued for Red Mango Yogurt Shop and Fresko Yogurt and Juice Bar
- 90% of the 21 respondents to the permit counter survey "agreed" or "strongly agreed" that their overall service experience was excellent.




Year-to-Date Permit Application Volume and Revenue Through end of March for Each Year

With the break in cold weather, the number of permit applications increased 75 percent from the previous month but the YTD number is still substantially lower than last year this time. Permit revenue was down about 17 percent compared to this time last year.




Total number of plan review applications doubled from the previous month primarily due to lower complexity projects. As of the end of the month, there were 37 applications in the plan review queue with 8 cases overdue an average of 6 days.




Plan Review Volume and Initial Review Pass Rate by Permit Category March 2014
