

# Construction Activity Notice

As part of the Green Line West Track Renewal Project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

- Dates:** Friday, April 29 through Monday, May 2, 2016  
Friday, May 6 through Monday, May 9, 2016
- Location:** CTA Green Line elevated tracks from Harlem to Latrobe
- Work Days/Hours:** 7pm Friday to 6am Monday
- Work Activity:** Tie Replacement
- Impact to Residents:**
- South Boulevard will be closed from Marion Street to Harlem Avenue. Pedestrian access will be maintained on one side of the street.
  - The viaduct at Lombard Avenue/South Boulevard will be closed to traffic.
  - “No Parking” restrictions and temporary parking area closures along South Boulevard will be in effect as follows:
    - o Austin Boulevard to Humphrey Avenue will be closed.
    - o West of Lombard Avenue will be closed.
    - o Humphrey Avenue to alley will be closed.
  - Corcoran Place curb separated parking areas from Pine Avenue to Parkside Avenue and Waller Avenue to Menard Avenue will be closed.
  - Westbound lane closure on Lake Street from Latrobe Avenue to Pine Avenue. Traffic will be maintained in both directions.
  - Pedestrian access under viaducts and to businesses will be maintained.
  - There will be noise while the work is being performed.  
Noise may include:
    - Engine noise from diesel track maintenance equipment
    - Beeping from backup alarms on track maintenance equipment
    - Metal on metal hammering
  - Shuttle buses will replace Green Line rail service between the Harlem/Lake and Laramie stations. Green Line trains will operate between Laramie, Downtown, and Ashland/63rd-Cottage Grove.
