



COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic Information


Thank you for completing your registration.

The Oak Park Department of Public Health is hosting COVID-19 vaccine clinics at the Oak Park Public Works Center, 201 South Blvd. Please see clinic information below.

Directions:

Please enter South Boulevard by coming north on Cuyler Avenue from Pleasant Street. A Police Officer will direct you to turn right onto South Boulevard. Continue on South Boulevard until you pass Harvey Avenue. Village Police Officers and/or clinic staff will review your forms, verify a driver's license/state ID and will direct you into the building and through the entire process.

Clinic Process:

When you enter the screening area prior to entering the Public Works Center, show the clinic staff your completed registration ticket. Once your forms have been screened, you will be asked to turn right to enter the building, as well as which lane to enter into. Continue into the building in your designated lane, and stop the vehicle where the signs indicate. Please turn off the vehicle. The vaccinators will administer the vaccine. After all vaccinations in your vehicle have been completed, restart the vehicle and follow the traffic control signs to exit the building and turn right onto South Boulevard. Clinic staff will direct you to a parking spot on South Boulevard to wait for 15 minutes. Once you have waited the recommended time, you will be directed to exit the area by going east on South Boulevard.

What to bring to the vaccination clinic:

Please bring the completed registration ticket or be prepared to show it on a smart phone and a state-issued photo ID.

To minimize the chance of spreading COVID-19, please bring a pen for signatures, if needed.

There is no charge for the vaccine and no insurance information is needed.

As you will be inside your car throughout the vaccination process, please remove any coats, jackets or other outer clothing prior to entering the vaccination area to speed up the process. Vaccine will be administered in your shoulder, so please wear appropriate clothing to ensure the process runs smoothly.
