



Pete's Temporary Construction Mural Project Guidelines

Site: Selected art will be printed onto a mesh material that will be secured onto a chain link fence that will surround the construction at 644 Madison St.

Application: Please complete the application and email it back to info@oakparkareaartscouncil.org. A rendering of the proposed mural for this project must be submitted along with the completed application. Proposals for up to three (3) original designs may be submitted by each artist.

Materials: Artwork must be high quality and able to be printed to the banner size of 10ft. wide x 6ft. high.

Criteria for Artist Selection: All work must be original. Murals may not incorporate wording aside from the Pete's logo. The panel of judges will review all applications and renderings to determine the finalists. Artists applying for the project must be 18 years of age or older. Art will be reviewed for Artistic Merit, Appropriateness to Public Presentation and Originality.

Panel Meeting and Notification: The selected artists will make themselves available to discuss the project scope and their concept prior to award notifications if needed by the selection panel. Artists will be notified of their award by email. If selected, the selected artist shall enter into a Mural Agreement with the Village of Oak Park in substantially the form attached hereto.

Stipend: Stipend for the mural is \$10,000. Artists will receive half of the stipend after the contract has been signed and prior to the printing the mural. The remaining balance of the stipend will be paid upon completion of the project.

Insurance: The Artist shall provide the Village with a "Certificate of Liability Insurance" naming the Village of Oak Park as "additional insured" prior to installation of the project in the amount of \$500,000 for comprehensive liability/bodily injury and property damage. Said certificate must be received by the Village before the installation of the Project.

November 1, 2024 - Deadline for artists submittals

November 11, 2024 - Selection and Notification

GUIDELINES

Factors to be considered by the Pete's Mural Project Selection Panel in recommending approval, of public artwork on Village or other approved public property shall include, but not be limited to the following:

- 1. Artistic quality.** The artist's concept, vision and craftsmanship for the artwork are of strong artistic quality.
- 2. Site.** The artwork and site are appropriate in scale, materials, form and content for the immediate, general, social and physical environments with which they are to relate.
- 3. Public Safety.** Each work shall be evaluated to ensure that it does not present a hazard to public safety.
- 4. Diversity.** When soliciting artworks the selection panel shall seek work from artists of diverse racial, sexual and cultural identities. The program also shall strive for diversity to style, scale, media and numbers of artists represented. Exploratory types of work as well as established art forms shall be encouraged. Artists must be 18 years of age or older to apply.

5. Feasibility. Proposals shall be evaluated relative to their feasibility and convincing evidence of the artist's ability to successfully complete the work as proposed. Factors to be considered include, but are not limited to, project, time line, artist's experience, and soundness of materials.

6. Duplication. Artists are required to warrant that artwork is their own original, unique design and an edition of one or part of a limited edition, and to warrant artwork is not infringing on copyrighted materials.

7. Production. Artists must create the artwork selected by the jury.
