## **<u>Developer Presentation</u>** – Public Art Maple and Chicago Ave. Development

Paul Zimmerman and Jonathan Shack appeared before the Public Art Advisory Commission as representatives of the proposed residential development at Chicago Ave and Maple. Mr. Zimmerman and Shack stated that they had submitted an Planned Development Application seeking zoning relief for their project and that the installation of public art in the project was required.

The developers stated that the proposed development included 10 luxury residential units with parking available to the residents on the ground level. They indicated that they intended to install a green roof and a green wall on the east façade and that they hoped to break ground before the end of the summer.

Mr. Shack and Mr. Zimmerman stated that the installation of 3 dimensional art would be problematic as the site was severely constricted with little to no room for public art. As an alternative the developers propose exploring the use of the 4 windows casements along the Chicago Ave. façade to hold public art such as artistic etchings. Examples of this concept were presented to the PAAC for review and discussion.

After a brief discussion the Commission agreed that 3 dimensional art would be work on this site and that the use of the Chicago Ave. windows for public art would be appropriate. The following motion was made:

Motion: To support specially designed window treatments at the Maple and Chicago Ave development site with the following conditions:

- Every attempt be made to include lighting into the design
- Continuity in design be stressed throughout the four window panels
- The PAAC be included in the selection of the final design
